

Consumer Collections FAQ's

1. How soon after placement can a file move to legal action ?

We can start the suit audit review process in as little as 40 days from the date the MVN was mailed.

2. How long does a lawsuit once filed take to get to a judgment?

Assuming service can be perfected and no answer is filed generally 120- 150 days (some courts take longer due to backlogs).

3. What are the benefits of filing a lawsuit and obtaining a judgment?

Consumer will realize the matter has just become more serious, SOL is extended or eliminated, Post judgment remedies can be filed to collect money eg. Judgment Lien - encumbers real property, wage garnishment, bank garnishment (state laws vary on what remedies may be available).
